The purpose of this Tobacco Scholars Program is to support post-graduate students to undertake research studies in tobacco development at various universities of Pakistan. Preference will be given to candidates who prefer to choose their career in the tobacco industry. These scholarships will provide an opportunity for students to broaden their knowledge of the impact of tobacco on the economy and well-being of people in Pakistan through involvement in tobacco-related research projects.

Scholarship amount: Rs. 100000 per year (maximum for one year)
